


File Setup Guidelines:

Photoshop / Raster Files in JPG Format

Check List:




- Create the artwork in full size at 100 dpi Resolution (Half Size at 200 dpi / Quater Size at 400 dpi)
 - CMYK Color mode
 - Bleed: 2" for Banners and .25" for Flat Bed prints. Live area should be marked with guides.
 - If your print need to be Cut-to-Shape, create the file in Vector Format.
 - Apply Rich Black (C 75% + M 75% + Y 75% + K 100%) instead of Black (K 100%)
 - Save the file jpg format in Maximum Image Quality.
 - File should have .jpg extension.
- Let us know the PMS # if any colors are to be matched.
 - Add additional bleed if you need custom finishing which requires more bleed.
 - Save your native files with you, if we need them we will contact you.
 - Vector file prints better quality compared to raster.
 - Your files will be archived for one year for your reorder convenience.



Vector Files in eps / pdf Format

Check List:

- Create scaled files (50% or 25% of the print size) if the artwork is more than 50"
 - Linked images should be in CMYK and at 300 dpi resolution
 - Embed all the linked images
 - Outline all fonts
 - CMYK Color mode
 - Bleed: 2" for Banners and .25" for Flat Bed prints. Live area should be marked.
 - Flat Bed prints with Cut-to-Shape, provide the Die Line on a separate layer.
 - Apply Rich Black (C 75% + M 75% + Y 75% + K 100%) instead of Black (K 100%)
 - Over Print Colors (Attributes) should be unchecked
 - Save / Export the files in eps / pdf format in maximum (Press Quality).
 - File should have .eps / .pdf extension.
- Let us know the PMS # if any colors are to be matched.
 - Add additional bleed if you need custom finishing which requires more bleed.
 - Save your native files with you, if we need them we will contact you.
 - Your files will be archived for one year for your reorder convenience.
